Dear colleagues and founding ADPARE members, thank you for your courage, work and dedication! The ADPARE Association was created, has grown and has development with the help of such beautiful and courageous people.

It's been 20 years full of achievements and challenges. Through this adventure, we have been joined and supported by warm-hearted colleagues and volunteers, fully dedicated and involved collaborators and devoted and trustworthy partners. We grew, we learned to overcome our limits, we've developed local, national and international partners, we learned for each other, we fought for the protection and compliance of victims' rights at both national and international levels.

Through its 20 years long activity, ADPARE supported 1595 victims

1595 people were our partners and together we worked, we modified and readapted our approaches, we outlined and re-outlined out activities. Thus, we thank them for their trust and for everything we learned in those 20 years. Thank you, beautiful and unique people!

ADPARE continued its activities fighting against human trafficking and channelled its efforts towards maintaining and developing the ACASĂ Programme – the specialized protection and assistance programme for victims of trafficking in persons. During 2023 ADPARE has coordinated 300 victims in judiciary proceedings and collaborated with a total of 18 lawyers, 11 psychotherapists and 4 clinical expert psychologists at a national level.

Protection and assistance services for minor victims of trafficking were provided exclusively with the participation of guardians, both family members and representatives of social assistance and child protection services.

The integrated provision of assistance and protection services also involved this year the provision of services for the dependents of the victims (dependent minor children), as well as for the parents/support persons/guardians, in the case of minor victims.

ACASĂ Programme

Specialized protection and assistance program for victims of trafficking in human beings

The aim of the protection and assistance program for victims of trafficking in human beings is to generate a comprehensive and flexible mechanism for assisting victims of trafficking in human beings, regardless of age, gender, ethnicity, religious affiliation, and socio-economic status to overcome vulnerability and build independent living skills, by providing integrated assistance and partnership services.

Specialized protection and assistance services for victims of trafficking in human beings are permanent and have been provided in collaboration with relevant international institutions, NGOs and organizations in the field.

The protection and assistance services are approached in a flexible mode, adapted to the needs of the beneficiaries, the working method being case management, to focus on the beneficiaries' resources, motivation for change and their initiatives, in order to increase the level of adaptation of the person to the requirements of an independent life.

The services offered under the protection and assistance program (crisis, medium or long duration) were carried out:

- in the family of origin or extension of the victims;
- at the ADPARE counseling center – here the victims participated in individual, group and family counseling and therapy activities; educational and recreational activities.
- in residential system / regime – in transit and long-term, in the protected apartment of ADPARE.

This year ADPARE directed its resources and efforts towards the development and betterment of the victim/witness coordination programme for judiciary proceedings.

This programme has been implemented in partnership with National Agency Against Trafficking in Persons as an integrated part of supporting efforts to assist and protect victims of trafficking in persons/minors and child pornography.



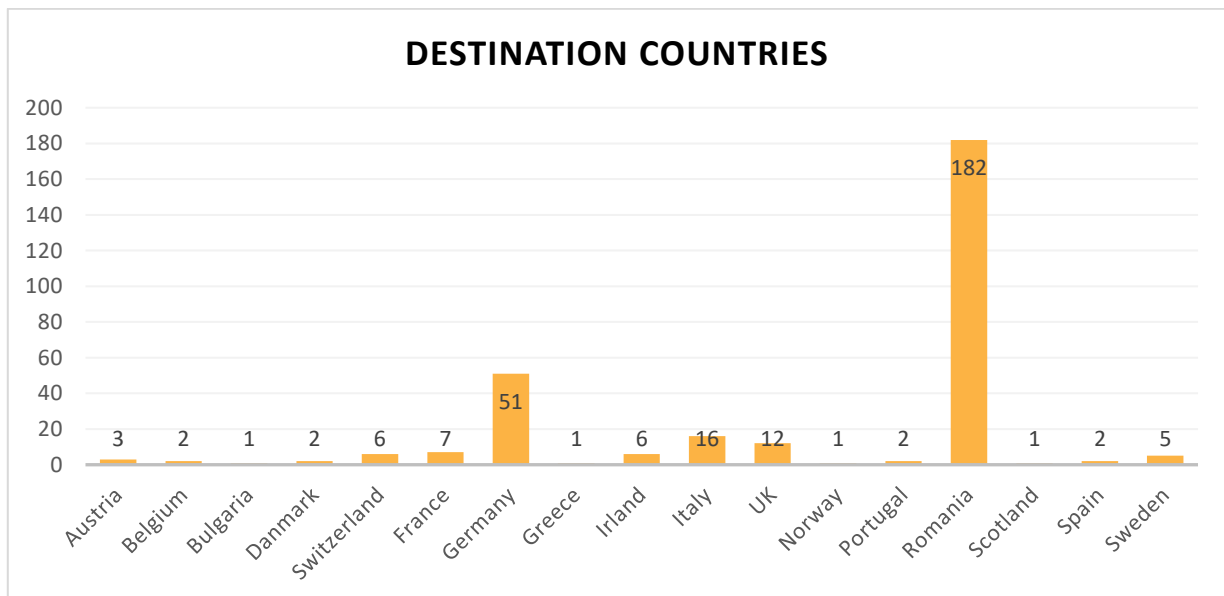
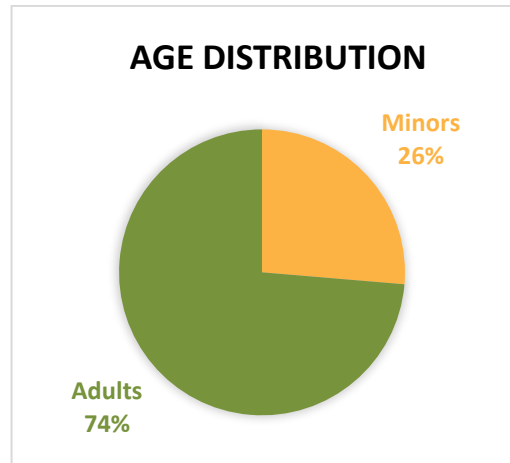
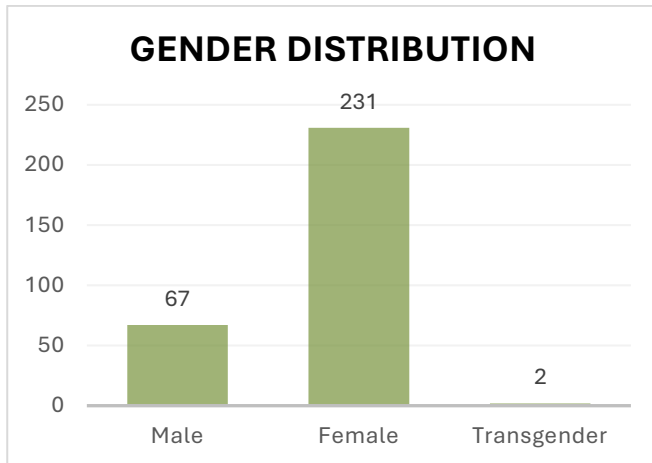
The coordination of victims and judicial proceedings represents all the measures, activities and specific actions adopted to facilitate the participation of victims in these proceedings, with an emphasis on protecting their fundamental rights.

Supporting the victim's participation in all phases of the criminal process (prosecution and criminal investigation, trial and enforcement), as well as in obtaining compensation for physical and psychological harm and financial compensation granted based on law no. 211/2004, which consists of:

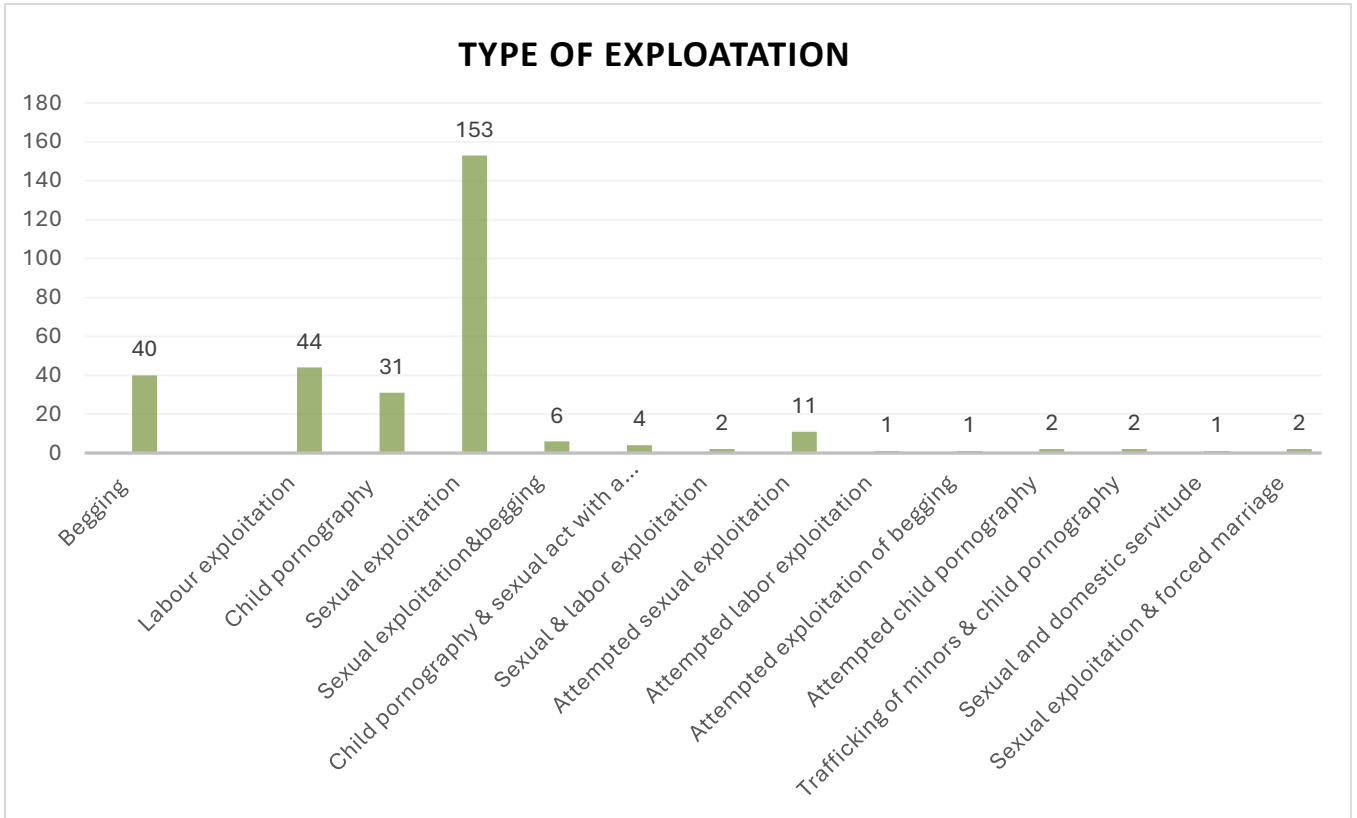
- Accompanying and emotional support during hearings;
- Permanent information;
- Legal representation through specialized lawyers;
- Clinical psychological expertise at the request of criminal investigation bodies and judges;
- Emergency and safe accommodation;
- Ensuring safe transport;
- Financial support during hearings.

Characterizing the Victims Assisted Through 2023

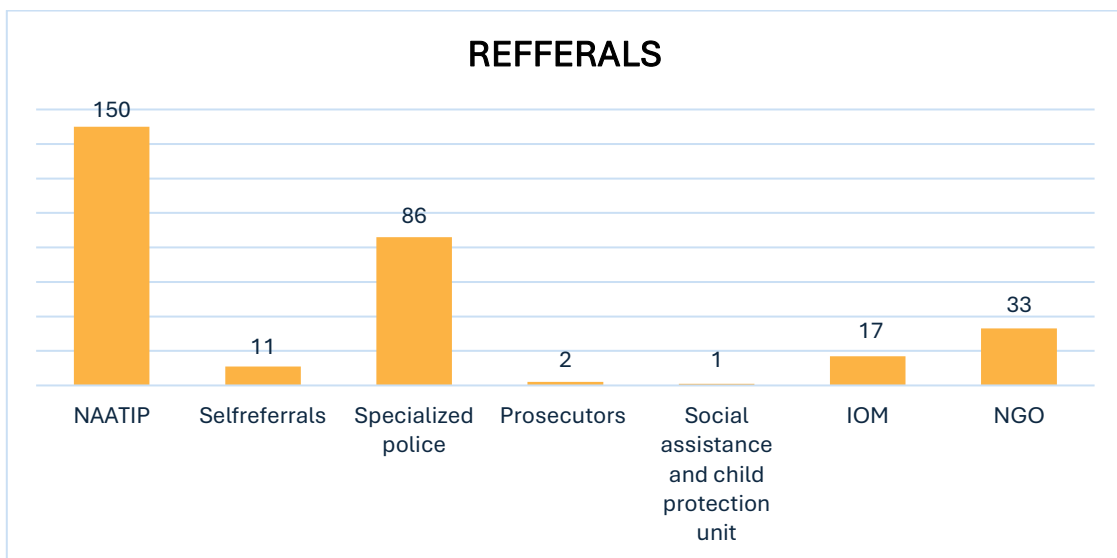
Through the ACASĂ Programme, ADPARE has offered specialized services to 300 victims of human trafficking in 2023. Out of the 300 victims which benefitted from specialized services, 167 were referred in 2023 and another 133 were referred in previous years.

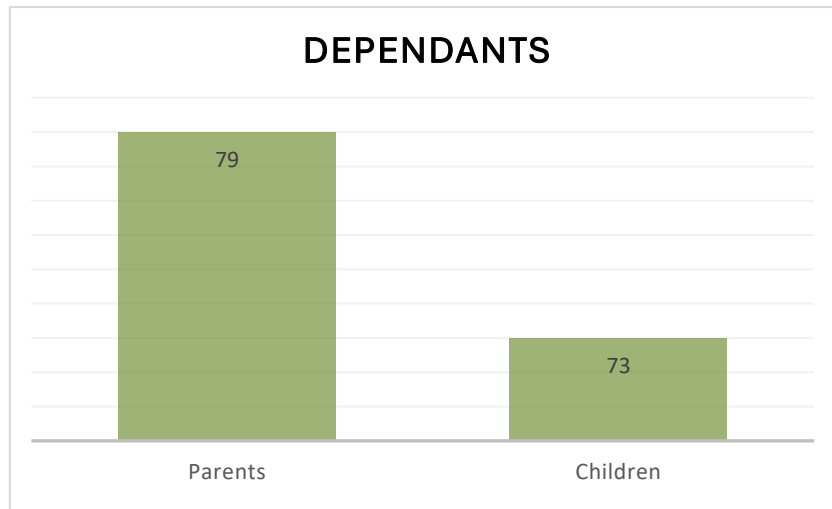


Out of the total number of victims, 28 of them were trafficked in more than one country



Out of 300 victims, 15 of them have undergone multiple types of trafficking





Through projects implemented in 2023, the members of the team were involved in training activities for specialists which were focused on the detection and identification of Romanian and foreign victims of human trafficking.

Through active participation to common reunions of working groups organized by the National Agency Against Trafficking in Persons and within the Romanian Government, the ADPARE team contributed to the development of the the National Antitrafficking Strategy of 2024-2028.
